## Company background

First Medical Health Plan, Inc. (FMHP) is a fast-growing health services organization located in Puerto Rico, FMHP is the third company profiled in Puerto Rico's directory of the island nation's top 400 locally owned companies, as published in the "Caribbean Business" listing, 2014 edition. FMHP is Puerto Rico's only organization that features a network of health centers and pharmacies where most of the subscribers receiving medical services are not required to pay deductible fees. The organization's commitment to serving its policyholders has earned the loyalty of those who work in the manufacturing and service sectors, in both private industry and the government.

## Recognizing the problem

In the past, FMHP had used spreadsheets to build their annual budget from the top-down, without the active participation of their organization's departments. To make their budget more accurate and



to free up time for valuable analysis, they sought to purchase easy-to-use software that would facilitate the involvement of employees and budget owners from across the company.

FMHP's financial leaders also recognized that CPM software would allow them to unlock additional value from their ERP, which houses their transactional information. By automating their financial processes and increasing their ability to make accurate projections, the office of finance hoped to meet their objective of assisting their company's leaders when making important decisions.

# Integrated budgeting and personnel planning

Prophix's Detailed Plannina Manager (DPM) enables companies to build their budgets and plans at the detailed level using non-numerical attributes, such as job functions and titles. According to Gloryvee Carrasquillo, FMHP's Budget Supervisor, "Using DPM, we can calculate the payroll budget based on details for every employee and department. All of the salaries, benefits, and payroll taxes are easy to configure and maintain. We simply upload the payroll data from Microsoft Dynamics GP and make the changes in benefits or assumptions. This produces our detailed budget. We can also make accurate cost projections related to hiring additional employees for various departments and contrast the potential results with or without new hires. Similarly, we can compare scenarios with the original benefits and see what happens if the benefits change."



# The value of automated workflow

Prophix's Workflow Manager helps FMHP to consolidate administrative expenses from 2 lines of business, 33 departments, and 19 locations. The software's end users directly enter their budget information into Prophix, while other departments receive offline templates to submit their budget requests. These templates are automated to show related historical performance. Once the users enter their information, the software accepts the data and consolidates it with the rest of the budget—fully integrating it for use with other financial processes.

"Thanks to this module, the finance department can analyze our data on a daily basis. We use this opportunity to compare actuals to budget figures and certify compliance with our budget outlays.
